Scottish and Southern Electricity Networks (SSEN) are taking forward plans to redevelop the existing 132kV Beauly substation. The project is required to enable the connection of the Loch Luichart Extension II windfarm and to allow the replacement of aging assets at Beauly 132kV substation. In lieu of being able to hold face to face public consultations in the local area, we are hosting a virtual consultation exhibition to provide greater detail about this project.
