SSEN Transmission are taking forward plans to redevelop the existing 132kV Beauly substation.

What Is Happening?

SSEN Transmission are holding a Virtual Consultation Exhibition to gather your views and feedback on our proposals about works required to enable the connection of the Infinergy Loch Luichart Extension II Windfarm by replacing ageing equipment at Beauly substation.

What Are You Consulting On?

In recognition of feedback received from the previous consultation, plans have been developed for the reinforcement works required at the substation which include;

- The preferred option for construction of a new 132kV GIS substation building.
- Decommissioning parts of the existing 132kV substation.
- Decommissioning of three existing transformers within the existing 132kV substation.
- Replacement with three new transformers, all installed with noise enclosures.
