Proposed Loch Lundie Substation Pre-Application Consultation Feedback Event

SSEN Transmission invites you to come along to this consultation feedback event.

About the project

The Coire Glas connection project is required to connect the Coire Glas Pumped Hydro Scheme. This Scheme will be the first large-scale pumped storage scheme to be developed in the UK for more than 30 years and supports the UK target towards a net-zero. A new 400kV Loch Lundie substation and Coire Glas switching station are required to connect the Coire Glas Pumped Hydro Scheme.

This is the final event for the proposed Loch Lundie substation. We will be consulting separately later in the year for the proposed new location for the switching station and associated overhead line.

Why we are holding this final event

Following our first statutory event for the revised red line boundary for the proposed Loch Lundie substation in November 2024 we are holding this final feedback event to share any design refinements and our responses to feedback received following the first event.



During this drop-in event we will share the latest project information about our proposals and the project team will be available to discuss our proposals and answer any questions.
