About the project

The Coire Glas connection project is required to connect the Coire Glas Pumped Hydro Scheme. This Scheme will be the first large-scale pumped storage scheme to be developed in the UK for more than 30 years and supports the UK target towards a net-zero. A new 400kV substation and switching station is required to connect the Coire Glas Pumped Hydro Scheme.

Following our previous events in April 2022/2023, we are hosting the first of two statutory pre-application events for the proposed Loch Lundie substation as part of the Coire Glas connection project. The PAN process is a key first step in the Town and Country planning process for this substation and starts a 12-week consultation period for feedback and comments.

Why we are consulting again

We are holding this new round of events to present the revised boundary area for the already proposed Loch Lundie substation and to gather your feedback on our proposals. We will be consulting separately on our proposed new location for the Coire Glas switching station in the New Year.

During this drop-in event you will be able to view project information about our proposals and there will be an opportunity for members of the public and interested stakeholders to ask questions to the project team and share feedback.
