Agricultural Classification

- 4.1 - Land capable of producing a narrow range of crops, primarily grassland with short arable breaks
- 4.2 - Land primarily suited to grassland with limited potential for producing other crops
- 5.1 - Land capable of use as improved grassland. Few problems with pasture establishment and maintenance and potential high yields
- 5.2 - Land capable of use as improved grassland. Sward establishment presents no difficulties, some maintenance problems
- 5.3 - Land capable of use as improved grassland. Sward can be established but deterioration can be rapid
- 6.3 - Land capable of only rough grazing due to intractable physical limitations. The semi-natural grazing provides grazing of low value.
